I refer to your letter dated 19th March 2014 on the above subject for which it was asked:

How are elected members of local authorities involved in the local authority's whistleblowing policy?

For West Dunbartonshire Council (WDC), I would make the following comments:

WDC introduced a Confidential Reporting Policy in 2006. This policy was subsequently revised and renamed as the Public Interest Disclosure Policy and formally approved by Elected Members at the Corporate Services Committee in 2012. Under this policy, WDC's Internal Audit Section is required to carry out an investigation of any disclosures made in the public interest. Concerns raised are treated in strict confidence and when requested an individual's identify will normally be kept confidential. Every six months, cases are reported to Elected Members through the Audit and Performance Review Committee on a basis which respects the principle of confidentiality.
