Section 1 Children social services:

- Social services should not take a child away from their families without risk assessment in place and all allegations should be further investigated.
- Children who not on any order should not be forced by social services to do things which they do not want to
- Children who in care should have the right to stay in their same school and near families instead of putting far away because it can affect child life and education
- If a child who 16 in care has a right to keep the child and mother will be placed in accommodation for Mothers who in care.
- Social services cannot bring up the past without further evidence.

Section 2 Adult social services:

- Parents have the right to gain access to their child information from Adult social work but need permission from the adult themselves.
- Under guardianship order Social work cannot go for guardianship if there a
 family member in place and there no evidence they cannot take responsibility.
 Only time social services should be involved if there family member willing to
 take it or there risk or dead.
- Adult social services Should not force Adult to do anything or tell them what to do if there not on order
- Adult social services should renew a risk assessment every 4 motnths.
- If adult has child the social services cannot Stop or take child away them without evidence new one
