ITEM 3: Presentation from Mike Cantlay, Chairman of Visit Scotland, 'Developing Scotland's Aviation Ambition'.	
 ITEM 4: Assistance for passengers with disabilities Disabled Access Holidays member of SPAA report that the main problem is educating passengers to declare disabilities and specific need for assistance before travel. Access panel local to airport should work with airport to ensure suitable facilities for passengers with disabilities. Airports work with local disability groups to highlight areas that need improvement e.g. planning, way finding and pre-notification. Not one size fits all with different disabilities having different requirements. Airlines echo not a one size fits all problem. BA has improved the way passengers can book assistance service. BA sits on the Civil Aviation Authority disability working group. 	Airports and airlines will write a briefing note on passengers with disabilities. Convenor will email other airline members asking for their contributions. SC will collate airports good practice. CR will collate airlines good practice and find out if airlines give specific training to recognise rarer/ less visible disabilities. Briefing note will be discussed at the May meeting before being circulated to disability groups. Note will form the basis of a second members debate highlighting steps that have been made to address issues.
