(5 MSPs and 47 Non-MSPs) Andrew Faulk from Consumer Focus Scotland, Kelly McIntyre from the Fintry Development Trust, and Nicky Booth from Community Wind Power Limited gave presentations on linkages between renewable energy and energy efficiency.

24 January 2013 **Large-scale Energy Storage**

(7 MSPs and 56 non-MSPs) Craig Dyke (National Grid) gave a presentation on '*Transmission perspectives on energy storage*'; Andy Gregory (SSE Renewables) gave a presentation on '*SSE's plans for Energy Storage*', and Nigel Holmes (Scottish Hydrogen and Fuel Cell Association) presented '*Power Beyond the Grid – Hydrogen for Energy Storage and Export*'.

21 March 2013 **Scotland's housing retrofit agenda**

(4 MSPs and 36 Non-MSPs) David Fotheringham from the Scottish Government, David Stewart (SFHA) representing the Existing Homes Alliance Scotland, and Barbara Atterson from Energy Action Scotland provided presentations on Scotland's housing retrofit agenda.

13 June 2013 **Local authority finance and delivery models for energy efficiency**
