28th March 2017 - The initial meeting of the CPG to identify the purpose of the CPG, membership of the group and the workplan priorities. (MSP attendees - 3 Non MSP attendees - approx. 12)

27th June 2017 - Discussion of priority topics and potential co-working with other CPGs on issues such as disability, education and support for families with Autism. Discussion of the implementation of the Montgomery Review recommendations. (MSP - 2, Non MSP - 20)

5th September 2017 - Continued and brief discussion on Montgomery Review recommendations. Key theme was care coordination and specialist nursing for rare, genetic and undiagnosed conditions and the variation in provision across specific conditions. (MSP - 2, Non- MSP - 19)

5th December 2017 (Inquorate)- Specialist Nursing Meeting with Chief Nursing Officer Fiona McQueen to discuss the current issues around variation in specialist nursing provision for rare, genetic and undiagnosed conditions, the Specialist Nursing Fund and a proposal for a specialist nursing service for rare, genetic and undiagnosed conditions.

20th March 2018 - Scottish Plan for Rare Diseases - Victoria Milne (National Planning Team Leader, Scottish Government) and Angela Simpson (Senior Policy Manager for Rare Diseases, Scottish Government) attended the meeting to provide an overview of the Scottish Plan for Rare Disease, the policy context in which it exists and a summary of the Scottish Government's biennial report. There was also a short discussion on access to new medicines and the response received by the CPG from the Cabinet Secretary. (MSP - 2, Non- MSP 12)
