The session focused on the early detection of lung cancer where Oncimmune presented on their ECLS study. Members agreed that the CPG should collectively write to the Cabinet Secretary asking for an update on the implementation of lung health check in Scotland. The meeting also discussed Hepatocellular Carcinoma.

28th May 2020

4 MSPs, 79 Individuals

This meeting focused on the impact of COVID-19 across the cancer pathway. The group heard from Jason Leitch, National Clinical Director who updated on the Scottish Government's commitment to maintaining cancer services throughout the pandemic, this was followed by a Q&A session. The group agreed to collaborate on a report that would analyse the impact of COVID-19 on cancer prevention, early detection, treatment, care and research.

29th June 2020

1 MSP, 50 Individuals

The group discussed the CPG report 'Beyond the Data: a qualitative review of the impact of COVID-19 on cancer services and people affected by cancer' drafted by the secretariat, in collaboration with members. This session also featured a presentation from the Glasgow Cancer Test followed by a discussion on genomic testing. The Cabinet Secretary for Health and Sport and National Clinical Director for Health joined the meeting to update on the recovery of cancer services, participate in a Q&A and comment on the CPG report.

15th September 2020

3 MSPs, 41 Individuals

This meeting included our AGM with the remainder focusing on the recovery of cancer services, highlighting cancer support and wellbeing services in particular. The group heard from the Scottish Government's Cancer Policy Team Lead who updated on the national cancer recovery plan that is due to be published in autumn 2020.
