The meeting included an update on Scotland's Cancer Strategy and progress on access to Advanced Radiotherapy in Scotland from the Cabinet Secretary for Health and Sport, Shona Robison MSP, followed by a presentation from Hamish Wallace of the Managed Service Network for Children and Young People with Cancer to discuss the progress and plans for the group.

The meeting featured the Minister for Public Health, Aileen Campbell MSP, giving an update on the Scottish Government's diet and obesity strategy.
