SUBMISSION FROM MR AND MRS SHILLINGLAW

NB. The following submission was received by Mr and Mrs Shillinglaw who would like it treated as written evidence for the Committee and not, as the opening sentence reads, a petition. Mr and Mrs Shillinglaw also provided “petition sheets” with multiple signatures. These have not been published for data protection purposes as they make reference to third parties and contain personal information such as addresses. The clerks have not been able to verify the signatures.

This letter with petition is being handed over to Michelle Ballantyne. Today 31st October we will fight on for justice and this law changed so that grandparents, fathers and families are reunited. It’s been going on for long enough now. We want action. Now. Do you not have hearts?
