EU EXIT LEGISLATION – PROTOCOL WITH SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT

The Scottish Parliament recommended on 3 October 2018 that the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Charging for the Use of Certain Infrastructure on the Trans-European Road Network) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018 should include Scottish devolved matters, as set out in the notification to the Parliament.

The Heavy Goods Vehicles (Charging for the Use of Certain Infrastructure on the Trans-European Road Network) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018 was laid in the UK Parliament on 14 December 2018. While the final SI laid varies in some minor respects from the original proposal, this variation is not expected to have any significant impacts in Scotland and the SI remains consistent with the consent granted.
